Senior Exit Plans

Class of 1998

Each year since 1992, the Department of Education has surveyed our high school seniors about their education and employment plans after graduation. This report is a summary of their intentions.

A high school staff member, usually a counselor, collects post-high school plans from each senior sometime near the end of the spring semester. These plans are summarized at the school and the summary is sent to the Evaluation Section to compile a complete statewide picture.

Seniors were asked what they would *most likely be doing* the year after graduation. They could select more than one choice. For example, if a senior planned to work *and* attend school, then he or she noted both intentions on the survey. Appendix A contains a student survey form and the school summary form.

Response Rate

All 38 high schools with graduating seniors submitted their summaries.¹ Of the 10,459 seniors enrolled at the time of this survey, plans of 9,496 seniors were accounted for, resulting in a response rate of 91%.² Many of these responding seniors had multiple plans, selecting more than one of the following choices: school, work, military, undecided and other, for a total of 12,851 responses or 2,392 more responses than seniors who responded.

When compiled by district, the response rate ranged from a high of 98% to the low of 81%. (See Table 1.) School-by-school response rates, ranging from 46% to 100%, are in Appendix B.³

¹ Two of our high schools, Kealakehe and King Kekaulike, do not yet have a senior class. Ni`ihau is exempt from participating in this survey.

² Some slippage between the number of seniors enrolled and the number completing the survey is expected. The number enrolled is from the DOE spring count of seniors; the number responding may be higher or lower than the official count depending on the date the survey was taken.

³ If a school's response rate is 75% or more, the survey results are generally representative of the senior class.

Educational Plans

Almost 79% of our responding seniors intend to further their education after high school. (See Table 2.) Over half of these seniors (54%) plan to attend community college. Another substantial portion of these seniors (39%) see a four year college or university in their future. Slightly more than three quarters (77%) of these seniors plan to attend schools in Hawaii. Tables 3 and 4 have more detailed educational information organized by district, while Appendix C has this information compiled by high school and district.

Military and Work Plans

Military service plays an important part in the future plans of about 9% of our responding seniors. Honolulu District has the largest percent of responding seniors who plan to be part of the military upon graduation. (See Table 2.)

As for work, 42% of our responding seniors plan to have jobs after graduation. Windward District has the largest percent of responding seniors who plan to be working after graduation. (See Table 2.)

Appendix B has more detailed information about military and work plans organized by high school and district.

Comparisons with the Class of 1997

There is essentially no difference between the two graduating classes of 1997 and 1998 in any of the following areas: return rate and the percent who plan to attend school, military, undecided, or other. The largest difference (8%) is in the area of work: A greater percent of responding seniors in the 1998 graduating class (42%) compared to the 1997 class (34%) plan to be working.
