Senior Exit Plans Class of 1999

Each year since 1992, the Department of Education has surveyed our high school seniors about their education and employment plans after graduation. This report summarizes their intentions.

A high school staff member, usually a counselor, collects post-high school plans from each senior sometime near the end of the spring semester. These plans are tallied at the school and a summary is sent to the Evaluation Section to compile a statewide picture.

Seniors were asked what they would *most likely* be doing the year after graduation. They could select more than one choice. For example, if a senior planned to work *and* attend school, then he or she noted both intentions on the survey form. Appendix A contains a student survey form and the school summary form.

Response Rate

All 39 high schools with graduating seniors submitted their summaries.¹ King Kekaulike had its first graduating class in 1999. Of the 10,603 seniors enrolled at the time of the survey, plans of 9,460 were accounted for², resulting in a response rate of 89.2%, approximately 1% less than in 1998. Many of the responding seniors had multiple plans, selecting more than one of the following choices: school, work, military, undecided and other, for a total of 14,752 responses or 5,292 more responses than seniors who responded.

When compiled by district, the response rate ranged from a high of 97.5% to a low of 81.2%, approximately the same range as in 1998. (See Table 1.) School-by-school response rates, ranging from 52.2% to 100%, are in Appendix B.³

¹One of our high schools, Kealakehe, does not yet have a senior class; one high school, Ni`ihau is exempt from participating in this survey.

²Some slippage between the number of seniors enrolled and the number completing the survey is expected. The number enrolled is from the DOE spring count of seniors; the number responding may be higher or lower than the official count depending on the date the survey was completed at each high school.

³If a school's response rate is 75% or more, the survey results are generally representative of the senior class.

Educational Plans

Slightly more than 81% of our responding seniors intend to further their education after high school, approximately 2% more than 1998. Over half these seniors (54%) plan to attend community colleges. Another substantial portion of these seniors (37%) see a four-year college or university in their future. (See Table 2.)

About 75% of these college-bound seniors plan to attend schools in Hawai`i, about the same as those in the Class of 1998 choosing to stay in Hawai`i for college.

Tables 3 and 4 have more detailed information regarding our seniors' educational plans organized by district. Appendix C has such information compiled by high school and district.

Military and Work Plans

In 1999 military service plays an important part in the future of 9% of our responding seniors (see Table 2), the same percent as last year. Leeward District has the largest percent of its responding seniors (14.1%) who plan to be part of the military upon graduation.

As for work, 55% of our responding seniors plan to have jobs after graduation either as full or part time employees. This figure is 13% more than those from the Class of 1998. Of those who plan to work, 70% plan to have full time jobs. A larger percentage of Honolulu District's responding seniors (75.5%) than seniors in other districts plan to be working upon graduation.
